BROAD STREET OF RI ALLIN

- Collaborative effort among three municipalities (Central Falls, Pawtucket, and Cumberland) and Blackstone Valley Tourism Council (BVTC) to revitalize Broad Street
- **BSRI 1.0 began in 2007** and made significant strides but lost funding in 2012
- ▶ **BSRI 2.0 began in 2016** with renewed vigor and funding; Coordinator position funded by RI Foundation since 2017 to facilitate cross-municipality collaboration






Broad Street at Exchange Street, Pawtucket, RI Existing Intersection
